BARGAINING TO RESUME ON OCTOBER 5

On Tuesday, October 5, bargaining will resume even though there still is no state budget. The District has received the federal Ed Jobs money that can be used to rehire employees, for salaries, benefits and furlough days. This will be discussed at the table. The big issue is how to keep the district solvent with a 2% reserve over a three year period as required by law.

SUBJECT ADVISORY COUNCILS
